Parents and Students for the Class of 2022,

Attached is an overview of Summer Bridge for the Class of 2022. We cannot tell you how excited we are by this group of young scholars. We enjoyed meeting each one of you and getting to know what your plans are for your future in our parent and student interviews. There is a lot of work to be done before freshman year. We cannot stress the importance of parental support. We appreciate the sacrifices you are making over the summer to ensure your child's success. The prize at the end is their Associate Degree from TCC in May of 2022.

MCV4 Vaccination:

All entering students at an institution of higher education are required to show proof of an initial meningococcal vaccination (MCV4) or a booster dose during the five-year period prior to enrolling. ECHS will need proof of the shot or booster if it is not up to date. TCC will not allow your student on campus without proof of the shot. They will not be attending classes at TCC until the summer/fall of 2020, but it's important you have this information going into their freshmen year. If the shot is administered over the summer prior to their freshmen year, they will be in compliance with ECHS and TCC throughout all four years in high school.

General Information:

- Dates of Summer Bridge are June 4 to June 29, Monday through Thursday.
 - June 4 to June 28, Monday through Thursday is required
 - Friday, June 8, June 15, June 22, and June 29 will be college field trip days and participation will not be required
 - Permission forms for specific college tours will be sent home during Summer Bridge
- Summer Bridge transportation will arrive at a bus stop near your home between 6:30 and 7:15 a.m., depending on how close you live to Everman High School. It may take a few days to get transportation set perfectly, so please be patient the first few days.
- If your address is not correct in the EISD Skyward system please make sure to correct it ASAP.
- Breakfast starts at 7:15 a.m., Summer Bridge starts at 8:00 a.m., and lunch will be at 12:00 p.m.
- If you are not eating, and have your own transportation, the hours are 8 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- No student will be released before 12:00 p.m. from ECHS Summer Bridge. If a student needs an early out, a parent or guardian will be required to show proof of guardianship to sign the student out.
- EISD dress code is a requirement for ECHS Summer Bridge Monday through Thursday. A modified dress code will be in place for collegiate Fridays.
